Use these verses to help guide you in daily prayer for Alliance Bible Church as we seek to become the people God has sent us to be.

Sunday: Psalm 139: 23-24

Search me and know my heart; Test me and know my anxious thoughts.

See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting

This is my desire, Lord: To have you examine me, my lifestyle, my priorities, my calendar and reveal to me adjustments that I need to make in order to better live out the purpose you have for my life. Thank you, Lord.

Monday: Revelation 3:14

These are the words of the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the ruler of God's creation. I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other!

Father, you have examined me. Where you have found me to be lukewarm please fill me with the Fire of the Holy Spirit so that the spiritual gift you have given me will become a flame to warm the hearts of many and light the way for them as well. Tuesday: 2 Peter 3:9-10
